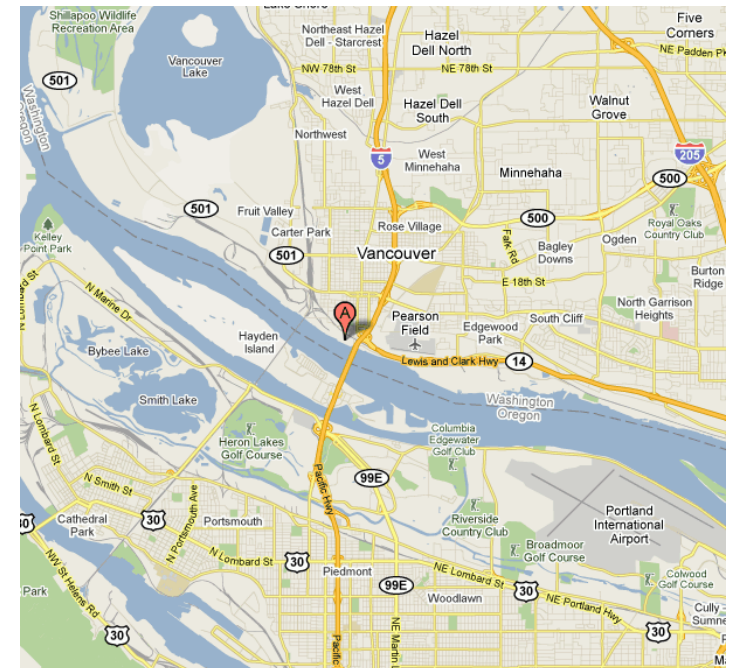

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Bred-by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility

- All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with AKC.
- The person handling the dog must be a breeder and owner of record on that dog.

Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in this class

Amateur Owner Handler Class Eligibility

The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

Bitches 7 years and up

(Involving Multiple Dog Entries)

Stud Dog Class: Stud Dog to be entered in Stud Dog Class and shown with a minimum of two and no more than four of his get. Get need not be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. Get must be entered in one of the Regular Classes. Awards will be based entirely on merits of the get. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed (Variety) by virtue of having won this class.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as above, except for the following two changes: substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog", and substitute "Produce" for "Get".

Brace Class: For two dogs with one common owner. Dogs and Bitches may be entered in the same brace. Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry, Specify "Brace Class" on entry form. One dog MUST be entered in at least one Regular class.

AWARDS OF MERIT

At the conclusion of the regular Best of Breed judging, the judge may at his/her discretion award up to a maximum of three (3) Awards of Merit, to any competitor for Best of Breed **other than the final Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch, and Winners Dog and Winners Bitch.** The judge is not obligated to award any Awards of Merit, if he/she feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition worthy of this award. The total number of Awards of Merit the judge is allowed to award is dictated by the total number of Dogs and Bitches competing in the Best of Breed Competition, the COUNT to include the WD and the WB, as follows: 10% of entries entered in BOB or 3, whatever is the maximum
